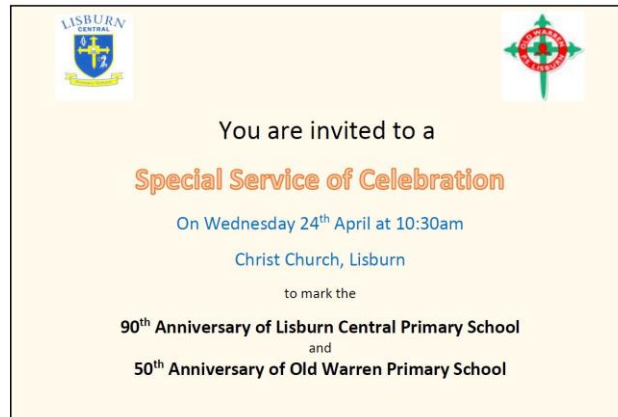
## School Fund
